We support the UN Global Compact and will respect internationally recognized standards for human rights, fundamental freedoms, democratic principles, and labor practices, as established in the International Bill of Human Rights and other key UN conventions on human rights, including the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, the International Labour Organization's Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work, the ILO's core conventions, the European Convention on Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms, the European Social Charter, and the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights.
